

Health & Safety Protocols for Visiting the Facility

HOURS & GENERAL INFO

- The Science Center will be open daily for General Admission from 9AM-5PM beginning Friday, June 26th with the following timed ticket entry times available: 9AM, 10AM, 11AM, 12PM, 1PM, 2PM, 3PM
- Guests who will be redeeming "Good Any Day" tickets are encouraged to call the day prior to or the morning of their visit to check on capacity limits. Please call (860) 724-3623 to inquire as to whether or not space for your intended visit date is available.
- Visitors can park in the garage beneath the Science Center at a rate of \$3 for the first hour and \$2 for each additional hour.

HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES

- There will be a mandatory touchless temperature check prior to entry. The maximum temperature allowed for entry is 100.3.
- Masks covering mouth and nose must be worn at all times (ages 2+).
- Practice safe social distancing by maintaining a minimum distance of 6 feet from other visitors.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer is also available throughout the building.
- Disinfectant wipes and "dirty bins" are being provided for guests to wipe down exhibits and surfaces before and after use.
- The use of hand dryers in the restrooms will be temporarily suspended.
- Some hands-on experiences will be temporarily unavailable when we initially open. This includes the Maximilian E. and Marion O. Hoffman Foundation Science Theater, and the Butterfly Encounter.
- Plexiglas safety shields have been installed in key areas to minimize the spread of germs.
