I am applying for a COA to replace the front door of my home at 121 Sunset Ln. The existing door is not original to the home but appears to be circa 1960's and is in poor shape. The existing door is a 4 panel raised panel wood door with 4 lights along the top and appears to have been cut down, not well, to fit the existing opening requiring an awkward locking arrangement, and is in poor condition.

Our intention is to replace the door like-for-like with the same style of 4 panel raised panel wood door with 4 lights along top. We feel this is in keeping with historic examples for home entrances, including some in the district. I have attached the COA application as well as a photo of the existing door.
