404 Berlin Turnpike (Map Lot Block:10-2-83-12-7333 & Map Lot Block: 10-2-83-12-7334); Map Lot Block: 10-2-83-13A; Map Lot Block: 10-2-83-13C-7509 and 10-2-83-13C-7510, Berlin, CT

That certain piece or parcel of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situated in the Town of Berlin, County of Hartford and State of Connecticut, bounded:

NORTH: by land of Goerge P. Arthur or assigns and land of The New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Co., or assigns (Middletown Branch), partly by each;

EAST: by U.S. Route #5, and land of Charles H. Brown, formerly of Lyman Nott, partly by each;
