POSITION OBJECTIVES AND PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Safeguards against accidents in the water and surrounding areas.

- 2. Enforcement of all rules regarding the facility.
- 3. Regulate activities, which may be injurious to others, or to public property.
- 4. Inspect, maintain, and clean pool areas as required.
- 5. Application of First Aid/CPR as necessary.
- 6. Rescues persons as necessary.
- 7. Presents a positive impression to the public.

DUTIES:

- 1. Watches the water constantly for distressed swimmers and potentially dangerous situations.
- 2. Make full written reports of all accidents.
- 3. Prevent the misuse of all equipment and report immediately any faulty equipment to supervisor.
- 4. Continual improvement of swimming and lifesaving skills.
- 5. Deal effectively and maintain pleasant, positive relationship with the public.
- 6. Must be available to work during the week and weekends.
- 7. Other duties as assigned.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

- 1. Current American Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED certificate
- 2. 16 years of age or older
- 3. Must complete blood borne pathogens training.*
- 4. Must complete Sexual Harassment training, as required by the Town*
