- e. Voted unanimously to approve, with conditions, the Special Permit/Site Plan Applications of 1897 for Alta Equipment for a construction equipment dealer use per Berlin Zoning Regulations §VI.G.3.w.and related site improvements at 1897 Berlin Turnpike.
- f. Voted unanimously to approve the proposed amendment, as modified, to Section VII.F.2.b. of the Berlin Zoning Regulations concerning greenhouses, Attorney Brad N. Mondschein.
