1 in 8 women will get breast cancer. 1 in 3 of these women with breast cancer will get Metastatic Breast Cancer (MBC). All women who die from breast cancer, die from stage IV Metastatic Breast Cancer. Median survival after a Metastatic Breast Cancer diagnosis is 3 years. Only 2% to 5% of funds raised for breast cancer research is allocated to the Metastatic Breast Cancer patient. There is no cure for MBC.

In November 2019, Jennifer O'Neill was diagnosed with Stage IV Metastatic Breast Cancer. She was 37 years old. She fought a brave and courageous battle for 2 years, exploring treatment after treatment. On December 6, 2021, she passed away at the age of 39, leaving behind her husband and two small children. Today, we carry on her amazing legacy by raising more awareness for MBC.
