Youth Beginner Classes: Red 8U, Orange 10U and Green 12U from 6pm-7pm Intro to Tennis (ages 4-13) is designed to bring kids into the game by utilizing specialized equipment, shorter court dimensions and modified games tailored to the age and size of the player. With a focus of using drills to improve balance, coordination and agility, kids will have fun learning and improve skills faster.
