

Council Votes to Create New Leash-Free Area for Dogs at Pistol Creek

When the Council passed the leash ordinance on December 14, 2021, the meadow area of the Bicentennial Park was designated as an off-leash area until another area in Town could be designated as one.

On July 26, 2022, the Town Council voted to designate a fenced-in area of approximately 50,000 square feet at Pistol Creek, which is in the middle of the fairway, right in front of the handicap parking lot off of Spruce Brook Road, as a leash-free area.

The new off-leash area for dogs will be fenced in and it is expected to be completed by the end of August. Once the fence is up, the off-leash area will be available for all residents who would like to bring their dogs to let them run loose inside the fenced in area. Dog owners are required to have control of their dogs at all times.

Once the leash-free area is opened at Pistol Creek, dogs will have to be on a leash in all other public spaces in Town, including the meadow area of the Bicentennial Park.
