REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- 1. Registration for pool passes will start on **Monday, May 6** and can only be purchased in person. Registration for swim lessons will begin on **Monday, May 20**, and can be done on-line (WebTrac), starting at 8 a.m. or in the office starting at 8:30 a.m. You must purchase a household pool pass to be able to register for swim lessons. **Age is determined by first date of the class.**
- 2. You must register in person for swim passes. You can register on-line or in person for swim team and swim lessons but you must have a household swim pass to register for lessons. If you register on-line for swim team, you must come in the office for your free swim pass.

Hours for registration in person at the Berlin Parks and Recreation Department, 230 Kensington Rd., are Monday through Wednesday 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Thursday 8:30 a.m.-7 p.m. and Friday 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m. The office will be closed on Monday, May 27 for Memorial Day, Wednesday, June 19 and Thursday, July 4th.

WebTrac – Register on-line through our WebTrac program! Browse our programs and register for most programs from the comfort of your home. If you forgot your username or password, go into WebTrac and click on "Forgot your user name or password" and the information will be sent to you. You can find the link to WebTrac by going onto the Town website, www.berlinct.gov, click on Departments, and find Parks and Recreation. Click on Register On-Line to get to WebTrac. Click on the aquatics box to get swim team and swim lesson information. On-line registration is generally only available up to the last business day before the program starts. Check under swim lessons for additional dates and times about lesson registration. After that you can only register in person, if there are still openings.

VISA and Master Card will be accepted in person and on-line. Debit Cards will not be accepted.

The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any program, which does not meet minimum enrollment requirements. Registration must be done in advance. In order to insure the continuance of each program, registrations must be made at least one week before the start of the program unless otherwise indicated.

Oops! Despite our best efforts, errors sometimes make it into print. We apologize for any inconvenience these errors may cause.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

- 1. Refund will be automatic if a program is cancelled or registrants on waiting list are not included in program. Processing fees will not be charged for refunds due to cancellations or not being taken off the wait list.
- 2. Refunds will not be issued on requests made less than 3 business days before a program begins. All refund requests for any reasons other than cancellation by the Town or failure to include a registrant on a waiting list must be in writing and received by the Town at least three business days before the program begins. Summer Fun program has additional deadlines (see below).
- 3. All requests for refunds will be charged a processing fee of 10% of the amount, minimum of \$5/maximum of \$50. Fees will not be charged if Parks and Recreation cancels the program. Refunds for the Summer Fun program that are not requested by the Monday before the week that is being cancelled will also have the cost of the field trip deducted (\$35) before the refund is processed.
- 4. No refunds will be given for pool passes, once the pool season starts.
- 5. Refunds will not be given on finalized trips or program tickets.
- 6. No refunds will be given after a program has started.
- 7. When program fees are paid by credit card and a refund is approved, that refund will be given on the credit card.
- 8. Exceptions to this refund policy will be made in the sole discretion of the Superintendent of Recreation and must be based upon hardship or other good cause demonstrated by the registrant. **Processing fee will be charged.**
- 9. All refunds by check will take up to four weeks to process, from the time of request. Refunds will be mailed to you.

POOL AND PASS INFORMATION

Season Passes may be purchased for individuals, seniors and households at the Berlin Parks and Recreation Department office for Percival Pool. The fee for individuals (you must be 18 to 59 years old) is \$55, for Seniors (age 60 and older) is \$30 and for households is \$85. Pool passes can only be purchased at the Parks and Recreation office, during regular office hours and will go on sale Monday, May 6. Please fill out the Pool Pass/Swim lesson/Swim Team registration form for passes, swim lessons and swim team. Driver's license or other form of ID that includes a Berlin address is required. Everyone over 18 must show ID and/or proof of residency, in the office, to obtain their pool pass. Proof of residency includes but is not limited to, your name on a utility bill, cell phone bill, insurance card or tax bill.

Swim lessons are free as part of the household pool pass but purchasing a pool pass does not guarantee a spot in lessons.

The resident **daily admission** fee is \$10 for adults and \$5 for Seniors (60+)/children. Non-resident daily admission fee is \$20 for adults and \$10 for Seniors (60+)/children. All non-residents must be accompanied at all times by a Berlin resident 18 years of age and older or have obtained a non-resident caregiver pass. An adult 18 and over or a babysitter age14-17 who has obtained a caregiver pass, who is in proper swimwear, must accompany all children under 11 years old.

Non-Resident/Babysitter Caregiver Pass – Resident parents who need a non-resident caregiver or babysitter, age 14-17, to take their children to the pool may apply for a Non-Resident/Babysitter Caregiver Pass at the Parks and Recreation Department. You will need to indicate the caregiver/babysitters name and address and they will need to come in to show proof to obtain the pass. There is no fee for the pass but daily fees will apply at the pool.

Percival Pool – <u>located on 20 Highland Ave, off Percival Ave in Berlin</u> Pool opens Saturday, June 15, 12 p.m.-6 p.m.

Regular hours are Sunday-Saturday, 12 p.m.-6 p.m.* subject to change, check pool for updates

Family Adult Swim is held Wednesday's 5-6 p.m. 13 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult. Hours are subject to change due to activities at the pool; changes will be posted.

Percival will be open on June 19 and July 4 from 12-5 p.m.

Percival Pool will close for the season on Saturday, August 10 (if staffing is available)

BERLIN DOLPHIN SWIM TEAM

Swim Team practices will be held Monday-Friday, morning practices from 8-9 a.m. and evening practices from 6-7 p.m. starting Monday, June 17 at Percival Pool. Swimmers should attend 4 to 5 practices a week. Swim Team has two divisions: Junior for ages 12 and under and Senior for ages 13-18 (age as of July 1). The fee for residents is \$130, \$110 for each additional child in the same family. Deadline to register is Friday, June 28, 1 p.m. All residents will receive an individual pool pass as part of the program but if you register on-line, you must come into the office to pick up your pass. Participants must be able to swim at least one lap (25 yards) across the pool. Knowledge of competitive strokes would be helpful. Championship dates are Jr. Championships, August 1 for ages 11 & Under and Sr. Championships, July 31 for ages 12 & Up. Please note that the Boosters will also be collecting \$20 per swimmer, cap of \$40 per family, to cover concession start up, end of year party and league fees.

Metro Swim will be at Percival Pool Thursday, June 20 from 6-7:15 p.m. for the swimsuit sale. There will be no practice that night.

SWIM LESSON SCHEDULE

Registration will begin on **Monday, May 20**. Registration on-line is <u>strongly encouraged</u> and will start at 8 a.m. In-person registration will start at 8:30 a.m. when the office opens. Lessons are free but you must have a current 2024 household pool pass. **Household pool passes are \$85 and can only be purchased at the Parks and Recreation office, during regular office hours and are on sale starting May 6**. Registration is for residents only and you are only allowed to be registered in one class at a time, if you are on the waitlist that counts as your one class. At the end of each session, you may register for another class, if space is available but spots are limited and could be full. **Purchasing a pool pass does not guarantee a spot in lessons.**

As a result of testing of some participants to see what class they should participate in, there may be some movement of participants from one level to another, only if space allows. We cannot go over maximum numbers set by Red Cross.

On Friday, July 12, 19 and 26, registration for everyone will close at 9 a.m. and re-open at 12 noon. People who are currently in lessons cannot sign up for another session until after 12 p.m. on the Friday that their lessons end, if there are openings, so they can find out if their child passed or not, before they register. We will monitor registration and make any changes that are necessary, if people register for more than one class or sign up early.

All swim lessons will be held in the morning, Monday through Friday at Percival Pool, 20 Highland Ave.

Preschool Aquatics and Learn-to-Swim (LTS) classes, where age will apply, are determined by the first day of class, per session. All participants in Preschool Aquatics must be 4 years by the first day of class. All participants in Learn-to-Swim classes must be 6 years old. Per Red Cross guidelines, we can only take 6 kids per class for Preschool-LTS 3 and 10 kids for LTS 4 & LTS 5.
